

The Farrington Scholarship Fund
2025 Application

Washington State Patrol Memorial Foundation (WSPMF) Farrington Scholarship Fund is offering one trade school scholarship, in the amount of \$3,000, to be used to pay tuition/fees and books. *Scholarship checks are issued directly to the college.*

Who May Apply

- 1. Any contributing member of the Foundation who is active, retired, or disability status with the Washington State Patrol, their spouse or dependent children. (Members must be contributing a minimum of \$10/month to the WSPMF).
- 2. Any surviving dependent of a WSP employee who was active, disabled or retired at the time of their death, who was a contributing member of the WSPMF. A surviving dependent is defined as the living spouse who was married to the decedent at the time of his/her death, and the decedent was active, disabled or retired, at the time of his/her death; surviving children is defined as a natural child, stepchild or adopted child of decedent as defined above. A dependent child must be at least a senior in high school to apply.
- 3. To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, applicants must have obtained a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above as evidenced by official high school/college transcripts.

Scholarship Criteria

- 1. The scholarship will be awarded based on demonstrated financial need and responses to the scholarship program questionnaire and financial need essay.
- 2. Applicants must apply for trade school admission and show proof of enrollment before the scholarship payment is made to the school.
- 3. Applicants must submit financial information to FAFSA and must receive a Student Aid Report which identifies the student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC). This must be based on accurate income information for both parents. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to request a copy of your/your parent's 2023 IRS Form 1040, if needed. Inaccurate or inadequate financial information may void this application.

If the envelope is opened, the transcript is no longer official.)

Completed Financial Need Essay (Section III)

Selection Process:

Applications will be scored by a non-departmental scholarship committee. Applications will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

70% Financial Need/Essay 30% Response to Questionnaire

The committee's recommendation shall be provided to the WSP Memorial Foundation Board of Directors. The top applicant receiving the highest rating shall be awarded the scholarship. One alternative will be selected. Applicants will be notified of the committee's decision by June 25, 2025.
